## IRISH COMPETITORS READY TO LEAVE IT ALL ON THE TRACK

The Falls City Sacred Heart Irish track teams have big plans for the 2023 spring season. The Irish return a whopping 24 letter winners and will compete in the Class D-1 District on Wednesday, May 10, at Pawnee City High School.

The Irish will be led by Brian Lemerond, who enters his fifth season in charge of the SH track and field program. Assisting Coach Lemerond will be Linda Kirkendall, Tim Kirkendall, Holly Westengaard, William Reed and Doug Goltz.

Between the boys' and girls' programs, the Irish have combined for 11 state track championships. The Irish boys, seven-time champs, last won the title in 2014, while the SH girls are four-time winners, with the last coming in 2001 when they polished off a four-year run of titles.

The Irish boys scored 24 points at the state meet in Omaha last spring, placing eighth in Class D. Gone from last year's team are Jake Froeschl, Jakob Jordan, Brogan Nachtigal and Derek Schawang. On the girls' side Sacred Heart loses three-time state meet qualifier Ella Simon.

The cupboard isn't bare on either side, though, as each team returns plenty of star power.

The returning state meet qualifiers are Evan Keithley, Sam Dunn, Macy Keller, London Nachtigal, Jessica Wertenberger, James Froeschl, Joe Simon and Jentry Lechtenberg. Other Irish members looking to contribute this spring will be Riley Nelson, Vaughn Lenard, Jack Stice and Leila Frederick.

Coach Lemerond will also seek help scoring points from Rob Froeschl, Tate Wilcox, Brenden Lemerond, Alex Madsen, Avery Santo and Daycee Witt.

"I think we will have a good all-around team this year," said Coach Lemerond. "We lost some big scorers from last year, but I think we gained some potential scorers in some distance races that we haven't had in the past. My expectations never change, no matter who we have. Conference and district champs potentially and try to outdo our eighth-place finish last year at the state meet."

Sacred Heart opens the season on Wednesday, March 22, in Crete at the Pioneer Conference Indoor Meet. The outdoor Pioneer Conference Meet will be held at Tri County High School on Saturday, April 29, and the NSAA State Meet at Omaha Burke High School on Friday, May 19 and Saturday, May 20.

# FALLS CITY'S THOMPSON MAKING A RUN AT A RARE THREE-PEAT

The Falls City Lady Tigers are coached by Terri Hogue, who enters her 23rd year in charge. Assisting Coach Hogue this spring will be Don Coolidge and Quentin Coatney. The Lady Tigers will compete in the Class B-1 district meet at Platteview High School on Tuesday, May 9.

The Lady Tigers return four state-meet qualifiers from 2022 and 12 letter winners overall.

Senior RacAnn Thompson looks to make it three in a row in the Class B 100m dash. Last spring at Omaha Burke High School, Thompson repeated as the Class B champ and set a State Track Meet record in doing so, running a 12.03 in the finals. Thompson also won the silver in the 200m dash, running a school record 25.15 in the finals.

The 4x100m relay team of Thompson, Ashleigh Kirkendall, Taylor Kreifels and Lillian Thomas placed fifth at the State Meet in May, running a 50.21 to set the school record.

This spring, Coach Hogue will look to Thompson (100, 200, LJ and 4x100), Kreifels (100, 400 and 4x100), Kirkendall 100/300 hurdles, 4x100 and Madi Jones (TJ).

Hogue hopes for a top-three finish at the conference meet and to get as many athletes as possible to the state meet.

The Falls City boys' team will be headed up by Cody Hawley for the 23rd consecutive season and will be assisted by Don Coolidge and Quentin Coatney.

The season kicks off with the Doane College Indoor Meet on Saturday, March 18. The ECNC Meet will be on Saturday, April 29, in Auburn; Districts will be at Platteview on Tuesday, May 8 and the State Meet on May 17 and 18 at Omaha Burke High School.

Returning letter winners for the Tigers are Daniel Hollens, Isaac Frederick, Quenton Adams, Blake Rolfe, Wyatt Kreifels, Stiephan Fields, Keifer Adams, Bailey Thimmes and Kyle Daake.

Coach Hawley will look for Hollens to get points in the sprinting events, Frederick in the sprints and long jump, Fields in the throwing events and freshman Ryker McCullough should score points in the distance events.

"Athletes will look to set personal best often," said coach Hawley. "They will look to make the finals in each of their events to give them a chance to earn medals and points for the team."

The district competition at Platteview High School will include Auburn, Boys Town, Falls City, Nebraska City, Omaha Gross Catholic, Omaha Roncalli, Omaha Skutt, Platteview, Plattsmouth and Ralston.

# HTRS TRACK TEAM SPRINTING TOWARD THE GOLD

The HTRS Titan track teams have high hopes for the 2023 season. Head Coach Kara Engles begins her fifth season in charge of the track program and will be assisted by Donna Railsback and Caleb Lempka.

The Titans return a state qualifier from last season in JJ McQueen but lost Nic Knudson, a state meet qualifier in the high jump.

'Lightening' McQueen qualified for the 100m and 200m dash in Omaha last spring. McQueen just missed qualifying for the finals in the 100m dash last year at state, running an 11.38 to finish tenth. His time in the prelims would have placed him fifth in the finals. In the 200m dash, JJ again narrowly missed the finals, running a 23.35 in the prelims and finishing in tenth place. His prelim time would have placed him sixth in the finals. Knudson also competed well at Omaha Burke last spring, clearing 6'0 in the high jump for tenth place.

Coach Engles has a strong roster capable of producing a lot of points this spring. HTRS welcomes back nine letter winners, five girls and four boys, from last spring. Brandt Leech, a senior pole vaulter and freshman 800 runner Lillian Bowen are expected to produce for the Titans this spring. Coach Engles will also have returners Hunter Bohling, Brogan Dunlap, Laramie Glathar and Macy Vrtiska.

The Titans started the 2023 season by competing in the Pioneer Conference Indoor Meet at Doane on Wednesday, March 22. HTRS will compete at the MUDECAS Meet at Freeman on April 22, the Pioneer Conference Meet at Tri County on April 29 and Districts on May 10 at Pawnee City. The Class D State Track Meet will be held May 19 and 20 at Omaha Burke High School for the 51st consecutive year.

"Track's a great sport because each time out, you can easily set goals for yourself and work to improve," said Coach Engel. "We have several kids that are working hard to qualify for the state track meet."

The Falls City Tiger baseball program is off and running for the 2023 season. There will be some new yet familiar faces around the team this spring. Head Coach Kory Huppert is back at the helm, taking over for Coach Tom Bartek after three seasons. Huppert led the team for four seasons from 2015 to 2018, with an overall record of 25-55. The Tiger's best year under Coach Huppert was 2018, when FC posted a 9-12 record.

Huppert will be assisted in the dugout this spring by first-year coaches Jaxson Balm and Brandon Sells.

Falls City will also compete in Class C this season for the first time. Until this spring, Falls City has competed in Class B, sporting a 34-92 mark. With the new class system, FC looks to make some noise.

“With the addition of Class C to Nebraska High School baseball, some new opportunities are definitely there for us and many others,” said Huppert. “However, we have a lot of hard work ahead of us if we want to be in a position to compete for a Class C State Championship this season and in the future. If we can finish strengthening our starting pitching rotation, find some gaps with the ball at the plate so we can use our speed on the bases and truly come together as a team, then this group of young men has the potential to do something really great and will be exciting to watch.”

Falls City will look to a great group of juniors and seniors for leadership on and off the field this spring. Returning seniors include Jaxyn Strauss, Kyler Frederick, Jon Craig, Bryson Butrick, Alijah Hernandez and Silas Amanullah. Returning juniors include Charlie McNeely, Kadyne Strecker and Wyatt Olberding.

“Between our senior and junior classes, there are eight to nine young men whom I have been around for several years now and I know their passion for this game,” said Coach Huppert. “We want to get back to working with them to build a program that seeks out the competition, to teach our underclassmen to want the same and to have the willingness to work with the young players in our community to help them gain more confidence too. If we do these things, we’ll be a great team.”

Coach Huppert stated that there are also many sophomores and juniors he looks forward to working with and putting them in a position to contribute.

“We also have several freshmen whom we look forward to doing the same with who all have a real passion for the game,” said Huppert.

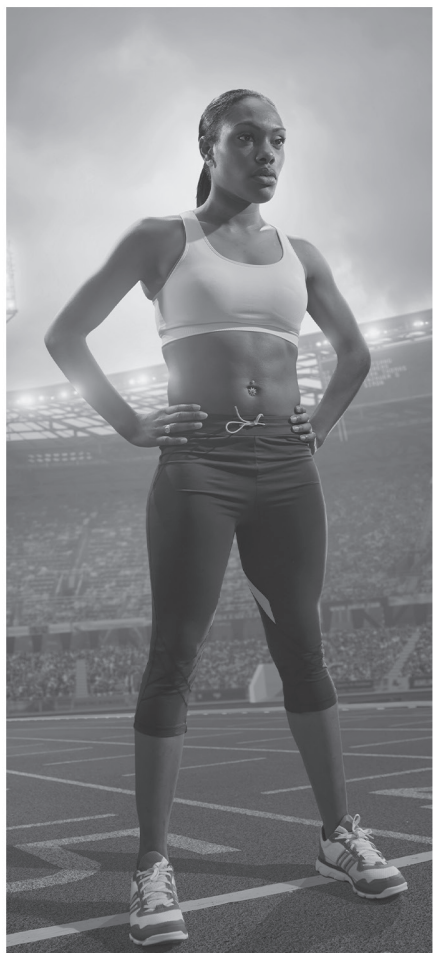

The HTRS boys' golf team will co-op with Pawnee City this year and include five athletes. HTRS golfers include returning letter winner Carson Refsdal, a sophomore, and classmate River McNealy. Three players from Pawnee City will join the Titans, including returning letter winner Justin Pierce, a junior, senior Brysen Horst and sophomore Isaac Seltz.

The season opened on March 21 when the team competed in a triangular at the Falls City Country Club. On Tuesday, April 11, Kirkman's Golf Course will host the HTRS Invite and on Tuesday, April 25, HTRS will host Johnson County Central for a dual at Kirkman's.

On Monday, May 15 and Tuesday, May 16, HTRS/Pawnee City will compete in the District Meet and on Tuesday, May 23 and Wednesday, May 24, the Titans/Indians will compete in the Class C State Golf Tournament at the Elks Country Club in Columbus.

Even with less-than-ideal weather to open the 2023 campaign, Coach Helms has high hopes for his squad this spring.

Hopefully, once the season gets started, the golfers will be able to compete in better weather than they have had to practice in so far.

"As always, a coach hopes that their team will end the year playing better than they started," said Helms. "There should be some better weather coming so we can get some quality practice time in and really get the season going."

With hard work and improved conditions, the HTRS/PC team should be competitive as the season progresses.

"My team goal for the year is to be able to field a full team at events (four golfers) and to have at least one state qualifier," said Helms. "Carson played very well last year and nearly qualified, so I am hoping he can get over the hump this year and make it. We have a very challenging district that includes a lot of very tough competition."

Falls City has sent two golfers to the state meet in the last four years, both while playing in Class B. In 2019 Braden Oliver competed at the state tournament for the Tigers; in 2021, Lucas Aldana hit the links at the Elks Country Club in Columbus.

As a team, Falls City placed second at the ECNC meet last spring with a 377, nine strokes behind the winning team of Cedar Bluffs/Mead. Individually for FC, Dalton Helmick finished third at the conference meet (84), Lindsey McNeely was seventh (93) and Carson Simon finished tenth with a 98 over 18 holes.

Simon, McNeely, Rayce Farmer and Helmick are gone from last year's team.

“We have some young players, so it’s too early to tell, but their work ethic has been great so far,” said Coach Kurpgeweit.

Aside from the returning letter winners, Coach Kurpgeweit will look for junior Danyelle Kuker, and sophomores Talon Anderson, Caleb McConnell and Rome West to continue to show improvement. Freshmen looking to make a splash are Ethan Morris and Jaxten Jorgensen.

“We are hopeful that Sophomores Robert Gilkerson, Talon Anderson and Caleb McConnell will step up into the varsity level and help the team. Our Freshmen class of Ethan Morris and Jaxten Jorgensen are also working hard to develop,” said Kurpgeweit.

The outlook for the season is simple, according to Coach K.

“Compete and improve each day in practice, learn to control what we can control and focus on improvement. We are a young team, our three returning seniors are asked to lead us and have done well so far and our underclass players have also stepped up,” said Kurpgeweit. “Many are hungry and want to compete at the Varsity level.”

Falls City opened the 2023 season with a home meet against HTRS and Auburn on March 21, 2023. FC will compete at the ECNC meet on Tuesday, April 18, at Crooked Creek Golf Course in Lincoln. The Class C State Meet will occur on Tuesday, March 23 and Wednesday, May 24, at the Elks Country Club in Columbus.

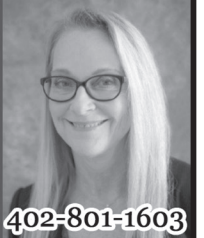
